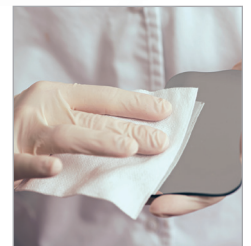

Bite check after filling | Oral Cancer Screening | Oral Surgery | Dry area | Protect tongue (lingual side) | Wipe instruments

USES - MULTIPLY SPONGES:

Bite check after filling | Oral Surgery (heavy bleeding/saliva)



What is the purpose/value of STERIPOCKET® SPONGES?

- Designed for dentists who perform extractions or oral surgery
- **Perfect for dispensing to patients** after extractions
- Time-saving - sponges do not have to be sterilized and packaged
- Economical because the number of sponges distributed can be controlled
- Sponges are **sterile** until used

Why Richmond FACE MASKS?



- **100% latex-free**, including the earloops
- 3-ply spunbound fabric provides **comfort and breathability**
- Face mask pleats cover nose, mouth and chin for full protection
- Soft aluminum nose piece maintains shape when formed to face
- **Level I Face Masks** meets ASTM F2100 Standards for: BFE $\geq 95\%$ and PFE $\geq 95\%$ at 0.1 micron
- **Level III Face Masks** meets ASTM F2100 Standards for: BFE $\geq 98\%$ and PFE $\geq 98\%$ at 0.1 micron
- Available in three colors: blue, lavender and pink
- Three types of Richmond Dental Face Masks are available:
 1. Anti-Fluid filters materials (Level I & Level III)
 2. Anti-Fluid/Anti-Fog filters and keeps loupes from fogging (Level I & Level III)
 3. Anti-Fluid/Anti-Fog w/Shield filters, keeps loupes from fogging and provides a protective eye shield with an anti-fog/fog-resistant coating (Level I)
