Anti-slip disposable absorbent floor mats

OUR anti-slip absorbent floor mats are now available via the NHS Supply Chain.

The disposable mats were developed with the safety of staff and the comfort of the user in mind. They help keep floors **clean**, **dry and slip-free** in a number of areas within the hospital, including **operating theatres**, **scrub areas** and **maternity**.

The mat **is designed to be stood on**, without any risk of the mat moving, in areas where fluid is an issue.

Mats are available in five options: **standard (small and large)**, **superior** and on a **30.5 metre roll** (standard and superior).

WHO would use this product?

Surgeons and other operating department practitioners, scrubs areas, midwives, urology departments, and many other hospital departments.

WHAT are the benefits?

A safe, slip-free environment for people to stand while peforming a job.

WHERE would the product be used?

Anywhere that fluid on the floor is an on-going problem and a safety hazard while working. This is not an emergency spill sheet - it's a mat that's designed to be stood on by the user.

WHEN would the product be used?

The mats can be placed around an operating table, for example, and the surgeon and/or other medical staff can stand safely on the mat. With absorbtion of up to 5 litres per square metre, it can sometimes last an entire procedure.

WHY would the product be used?

The mats are very cost-effective, especially when compared with similar products on the market. However, not only are our mats lower cost, they have additional features. A unique valve allows water to be taken up from underneath the mat and held - but this valve is one way; effectively the mat draws water up from below. This means the mat can be placed safely on a floor that's already wet without risking slipping.

ANTI-SLIP FLOOR MATS User instructions

The anti-slip disposable absorbent floor mat is always used with the orange (5-litre mat) or blue (3-litre mat) side in contact with the floor, and the white side facing up... so the user is standing with their feet on the white side.

Once wet, capillary action on the orange/blue side of the mat will hold the mat in place, preventing movement and helping to prevent slips.


This capillary action also means the mat can be thrown down on to an already wet floor - it will start to absorb and 'suck the water up'.

Once used, the mat can be safely incinerated.
